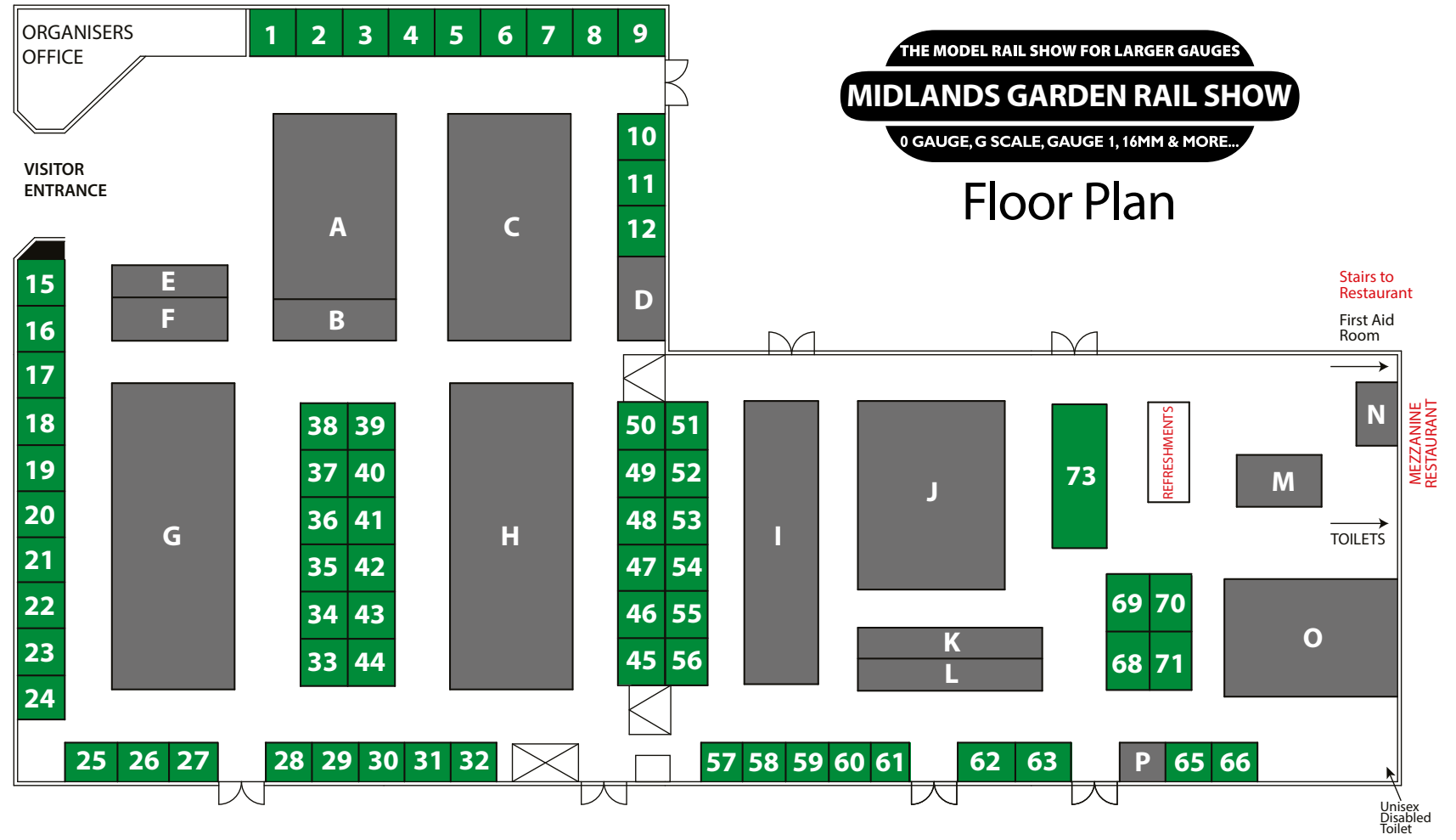

# The Midlands Garden Rail Show – Packed with action!

## LAYOUTS

### 16 mm Association Modular Layout

#### Stand: C

The modular concept enables the creation of a really large scale layout without the need to store such a large exhibit in one place. The individual modules are made by members all over the country as separate layouts which can be joined together in infinite combinations to suit the chosen location.

### Chalfont Gauge 3 Layout

#### Stand: K

Chalfont represents a small GWR branch terminus station and goods yard. Trackwork is hand built using Cliff Baker products, buildings are a mixture of kit built and scratch built. Locomotives are sound fitted and radio controlled. Rolling stock is all built from kits.

### Gauge One Vintage Tinplate Trains Group

#### Stand: O

Toy trains from 1900 to 1950. Proprietary makes, most in original pre-1923 grouping liveries. Over forty locomotives with passenger and goods stock. Six tracks running continuously on a 30-foot-long layout. Four individual collections combined as one. Questions welcome.

### G Scale Society Publicity Layout

#### Stand: B

The home of garden railways, displaying various aspects of 45mm garden railways and the variety of scales that we encompass. Come and have a chat with 'The Friendly Society'.

### Hampton End

#### Stand: A

Hampton End is a small branch line link serving the small village of Hampton End. Most of the freight that used the line was fish from the quayside. After the closure of the line many years ago, a group of local rail enthusiasts reinstalled the tracks & buildings & purchased a few foreign engines & stock. Most week-ends trains can be seen running. The buildings are from BR days. This international fair works well.

### Lough Motive Power Depot

#### Stand: L

Lough M.P.D. is loosely based on the track plan of Slough W.R. Following on from my last layout, Tolcarn, I have again taken the track plan from E. Lyon's book 'Great Western Engine Sheds 1947'. Owing to the Slough shed being built on the inside of the Windsor Branch curve, I have straightened the plan out to fit my baseboards, hence being "loosely based" on Slough.

### Mendip Vale

#### Stand: J

Mendip Vale is a portable exhibition layout representing the junction of two narrow gauge railway lines at a country station with a goods shed and yard. There is a loco shed and a branch line which leads to an animal feed merchant and a water pumping station.

### Newchapel Junction

#### Stand: H

Newchapel Junction is a large fine scale 0 gauge layout representing the post grouping period and based somewhere in the Yeovil area where the SR and GWR ran together.

The layout is entirely semaphore signalled and all moves are correctly signalled. Moves between Newchapel Junction Station and the circles are controlled by electric train describers. Electro-mechanical block instruments control the branch line. The signals and points on the main line are electrically interlocked and those in the main station are controlled by a relay operated entrance-exit panel. Signalling at the branch line terminus is controlled by a mechanically interlocked lever frame.

We create the impression of a busy railway in its heyday with frequent arrivals and departures from the main station to either the mainline circuit, where trains can be seen running at speed, or to the branch line where life is a little more sedate.

The locomotives vary from large mainline express passenger types to humble tank engines of both SR and GWR origin. Engines from trains arriving at the main station proceed to the loco yard to be turned on the power operated turntable before either going on shed and being replaced by fresh engine or returning to their trains for the next outbound movement. A large goods yard provides for near continuous shunting and marshalling of freight trains. Please visit our website at [www.newchapeljn.co.uk](http://www.newchapeljn.co.uk)

### Stanley Midland – Gauge One Layout.

#### Stand: G

Presented by the Midland Group of The Gauge One Model Railway Association. This layout is modelled on a fictitious main line station during the steam era, with island platform, goods yard and engine depot. It features scratch built, kit built and ready to run locomotives and rolling stock in 1/29, 1/32 and 10mm to the foot scales.

### Thomas Trackway

#### Stand: M

This layout has been built with children in mind and features the famous Thomas the Tank Engine and his friends. Locomotives and rolling stock are from Bachman and LGB running on 45 mm gauge LGB track. Buildings are mainly from Pola and Piko whilst road vehicles include products from Burago and Nex.

### Whiteleaf Light Railway

#### Stand: I

The layout portrays an electric light railway that runs through the streets and then sets off through the countryside to serve surrounding villages. Not all sections of the railway are equipped with overhead wire, so steam and diesel traction bring trains in from outlying areas. This type of operation was very common on narrow gauge railways across Europe.

Bromsgrove Society of Model Engineers - formed in 1982 – is based at Avoncroft Museum of Building and has facilities for 16mm and gauge 1 models. We meet every Tuesday, Friday and Sunday and operate a passenger railway for museum visitors. We have 70 very friendly members.
