
Our ground floor coffee shop can be found at the end of the main hall and our mezzanine restaurant can be found just above that offering breakfast, lunch and a great view of the action below!



LAYOUTS

16mm Association Modular Layout

Stand: D

The 16mm modular layout standard allows members to build one or more modules and be able to come together to be a part of a larger layout at various exhibitions during the year.

Barley End

Stand: B

Barley End is a rural country halt. The main employment of Barley End is the warehouse which receives barley by rail and transferred to road to deliver to the mill. Questions are always welcome.

Chalfont

Stand: L

A Gauge 3 layout. It represents a small GWR branch terminus station and goods yard. A regular passenger service is supplemented by freight workings shunting the yard and local dairy. All locos are battery radio controlled and sound fitted and are built from kits, as is much of the rolling stock.

G Scale Society Publicity Layout

Stand: K

The home of garden railways displaying various aspects of 45mm garden railways and the variety of scales that we encompass. Come and have a chat about all things G Scale.

Gauge One Vintage Tinplate Trains Group

Stand: F

Vintage Tinplate trains both in Gauge 1 and the very rare Gauge 2. Most of the trains and buildings are pre-WW1, and some were also produced into the mid-twenties. The buildings and accessories are predominantly Bassett Lowke with a selection of other manufacturers period accessories.

Halesfield Traction Maintenance Depot

Stand:

Halesfield Traction Maintenance Depot (TMD) is an O Gauge fictional depot created in 2024. Starting with the steam loco shed and the goods exchange sidings, then moving on to the BR diesel depot extension. From steam to diesel, a mix for everyone.

Lewiston

Stand: A

Lewiston has been off the circuit for several years, a great G Scale layout with a fiddle yard at one end and has a terminus station. It runs on Massoth DCC which controls all the locos and sound including the changing of point motors.

Midsomer Norton

Stand: G

It is based upon the Somerset & Dorset joint railway station at Midsomer Norton just south of Bath. The locomotives and stock 'are passing through' representing railways all over the country during the last 200 years. Fuelled by methylated spirits, gas, coal or battery electric, rarely run at scale speed or timetable but have fun running live steam.

Newchapel Junction

Stand: H

A finescale "O" Gauge layout representing the post-grouping period somewhere in the Yeovil area where the SR and the GWR ran together. The layout recreates the operation of a busy railway in its heyday with frequent arrivals and departures from the terminus station Newchapel Junction. The locomotives vary from main line express passenger and heavy freight engines to small branch line tank engines of both SR and GWR origin.

Putnoe Halt

Stand: C

Putnoe Halt is a fictional G-scale model railway layout. The layout is based on a small country village station with a couple of goods sidings. Most of the trains and rolling stock used is of foreign origin which works well with the layout. Just because they are large trains you don't have to have a large space!

Roche Junction

Stand: M

Roche Junction is on a main line where trains have to stop before continuing their journey on the single line. The line has freight going through the station.
