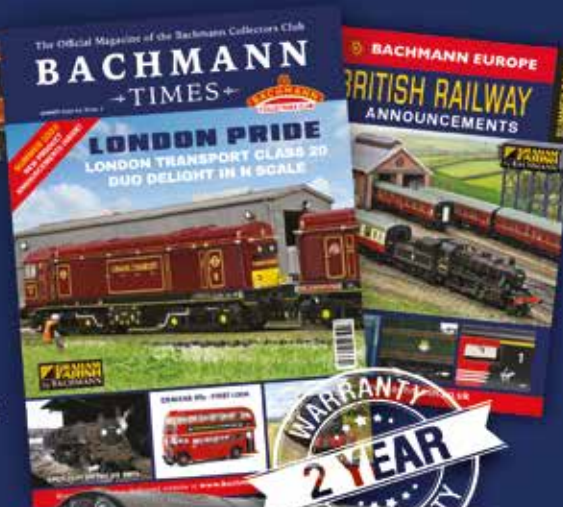

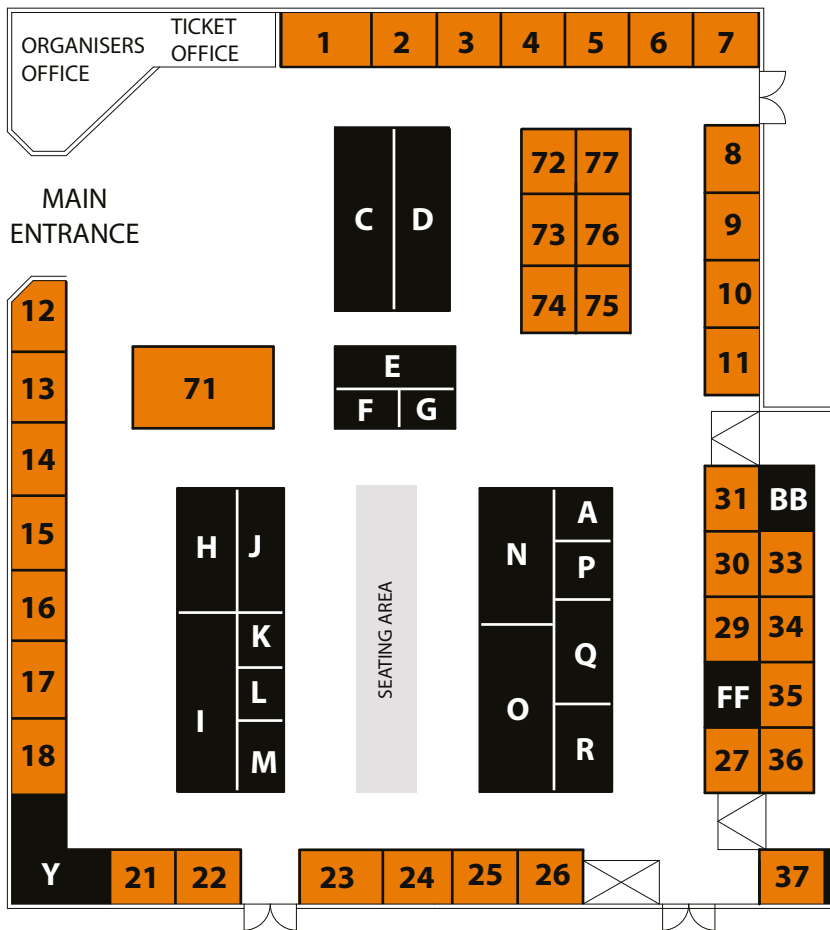

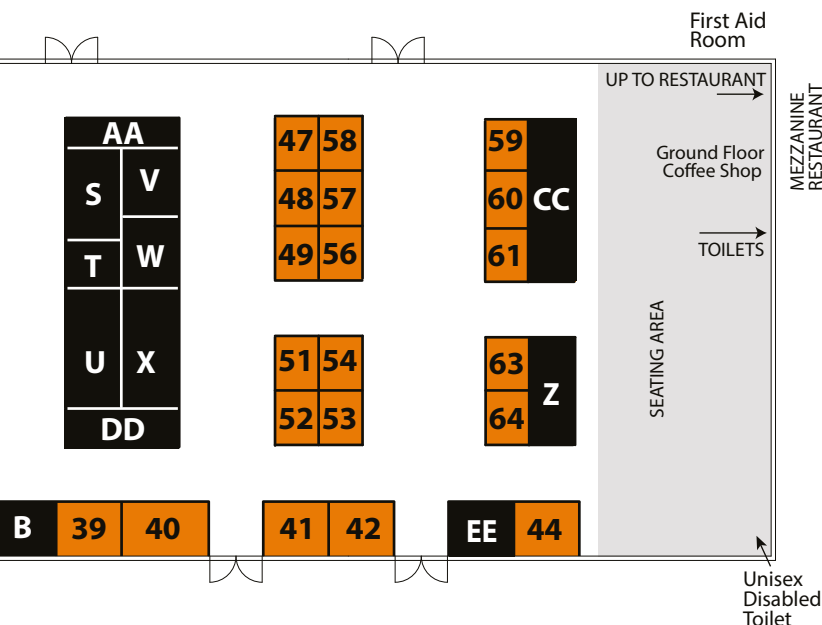

LAYOUTS

A Nice Layout **U**
The layout is 18ft long and features a double track main line, a high-level electrified branch, mineral branch and narrow gauge industrial line. The layout was built to run certain stock rather than a specific era.

Bear Creek **V**
Inspired by a holiday to British Columbia in 2002 and a magazine article by Chris Leigh in 2007. I have attempted to capture the essence of Western Canada with trees, rugged scenery, and grain trains. There are also bears roaming the layout so take care!

Brocolitia **F**
An N Gauge layout in a suitcase! With Roman ruin, working streetlights, canal, trees and ducks it has lots going on!

Brookthorpe **E**
A Lincolnshire resort town whose rail link was retained after closure of the line to Grimsby to allow continued freights to the docks, and summer passenger traffic which runs with a variety of traction mainly from Midlands towns. Freight traffic has also increased via the yard and docks.

Burdock **R**
Burdock came out of a desire to build a layout set in South Gloucestershire on the Swindon to Gloucester line. It is not based on any specific location but is an attempt to create something of the atmosphere of this rather picturesque area. The period is the summer of 1964.

Craigillin **D**
A fictitious location north of Perth. The station serves a small location which attracts cyclists and walkers. The old steam shed is still operational to stable locos for the timber and distilling industry. Passenger timetable includes local, semi fast, sleeper and one direct service to London Euston daily.

Culthwaite **B**
In minimum space, Culthwaite attempts to represent the less frequently modelled northern part of the Settle-Carlisle: Culgaith with a bit of Armathwaite thrown in. A sequence is run to represent the trains of around ten years ago, before the demise of coal traffic.

Dentdale **X**
The layout starts from the coal road bridge to Bleamoor tunnel and depicts Dent station and Arten Gill and Dent Head viaducts. We have also included St Leonards church at Chapel Le Dale moved closer to the Railway. We will be running stock from the Mid 50s to 65.

Dorcross Bay **H**
Dorcross Bay is a fictitious layout inspiration is taken from the famous sea wall between Dawlish Warren and Teignmouth. A small tunnel breaks the bay up. Access to the beach is a footbridge across the main lines. Set in the privatisation period from 1997 onwards.

Fordon Hill **P**
Fordon Hill is a simple double loop, mainly modern image layout with two stations, a small fun fair, concert, a busy town and a car that has argued with a tree!

Hatch End **N**
Based on the real location on the west coast main line north of London. Euston station during the 1980's with four A/C main lines of British rail and the two London-Watford lines of the underground makes for plenty of action. Look out for the APT-P on a test run!

Jones of Taunton **G**
The model is more of a fictitious large diorama with working N gauge buses rather than a railway layout. The layout is built directly onto a picnic table and measures 31in x 23in. It utilises the Tomeytec moving bus system. All the buses are commercially available and have been repainted.

Lisworth Bay **C**
The London and South Western Railway forged south-west during the 19th Century, sprouting branches to coastal towns on its way; Lisworth Bay was one of these. The branch was "rationalised" shortly after nationalisation and trains last ran in 1966. The track bed has recently become a cycle route.

Little Haven **L**
This depot layout is made up of 2x depot sheds, as well as a wagon repair shop and fuel point. It also has 2x stabling roads. With this layout it has a 4-road fiddle yard to the east end of the layout.

Market End **T**
A small DCC layout with two full working loops and a branch line that runs up to an upper level with a small market and shops. With lots of buildings on the layout that have interior details and lighting adding to the realism.

Neepsford Castle **A**
A simple dual track loop with a fortified castle complex rising above a small river and town set in the present day. The castle has a working drawbridge and beacon and is DCC operated with a Merg Controller and will run a variety of steam and diesel locos.

New Millfields **I**
Originally called Millfields, which has been rebuilt after 10 years stored in the back of the garage, is a four-track mainline running through the countryside with scale length trains. All stock is weathered and detailed. Period is BR Railfreight 1986-1995.

Oberdorf/II **W**
Imaginary location: Franco-Germany border. French motive power can visit Oberdorf in Germany. The stock had been created by marrying N Scale bodies with Z gauge chassis. Track gauge is 6.5mm. Period modelled: any time from the 1930's to the 1950's.

Peasehall West M.P.D **K**
Peasehall West M.P.D is a small fictitious locomotive fuelling and maintenance facility set in the modern era. The layout measures just 4' x 10", is DC analogue controlled and operated from the front.

Scarlington **O**
Scarlington is set in the Northeast of England with strong architectural influences from Darlington Station and the Tyne and Wear bridges. The period depicted is the late 1970s and 1980s during the sectorisation years. Buildings on the layout are all scratch built or kits heavily modified, a variety of freight and passenger trains are run.

Silverton **AA**
Silverton is a fictitious place somewhere on the outskirts of metropolitan capital, it has a twin track mainline with a secondary line going out to the suburbs. It also has a rail served warehouse and factory complex. You will see all types of rolling stock as it was built to run anything!

Singen **M**
A fictional Epoch V/VI rural setting in South Germany, Singen is a compact layout with operational catenary. Featuring a mainline station, branch terminus and long running lines with plenty of train movement to watch. Railway of the month in Continental Modeller in May 2021, this is Singen's first exhibition appearance!

Sugar Creek **Q**
Sugar Creek is a N Scale North American modern era DCC sound layout. Roughly based on the triple track section of the B.N.S.F marceline sub at Sugar Creek Missouri.

Vartanakert **J**
This layout tries to portray the nature, architecture and history of Armenia set in the Southern Caucasus. The railway winds past basalt cliffs, ancient churches, silk route caravanserais, mountain alphabets and cave dwellings. It shows the many fruit and pomegranate trees, vines that make Armenia the cradle of winemaking.

Whartson Hall **S**
Built to watch the trains go by Whartson Hall is based on Water Orton in the West Midlands on the old Birmingham and Derby junction railway with lines to Birmingham/Walsall to the west and Derby/Nuneaton to the east. The layout can be operated by Gaugemaster dc or NCB dcc. Please feel free to ask any questions as we all like to chat.

The display celebrates the beginning of N Gauge modelling during the 1960's through to the late 1970's here in the UK encompassing pioneering suppliers such as Lima (Wrenn), Micro Traction, Highfield Models, Westwater & Kirk, K's Castings, Bilteeze, Nifty and Cavendish Kits. The stand includes a demonstration building Highfield kits and visitors are most welcome to ask questions regarding early N Gauge

A display of early "Lonestar Treble-O-Electric" models. This will include models & sets made for the US market.
